Article 4 Direction relating to:

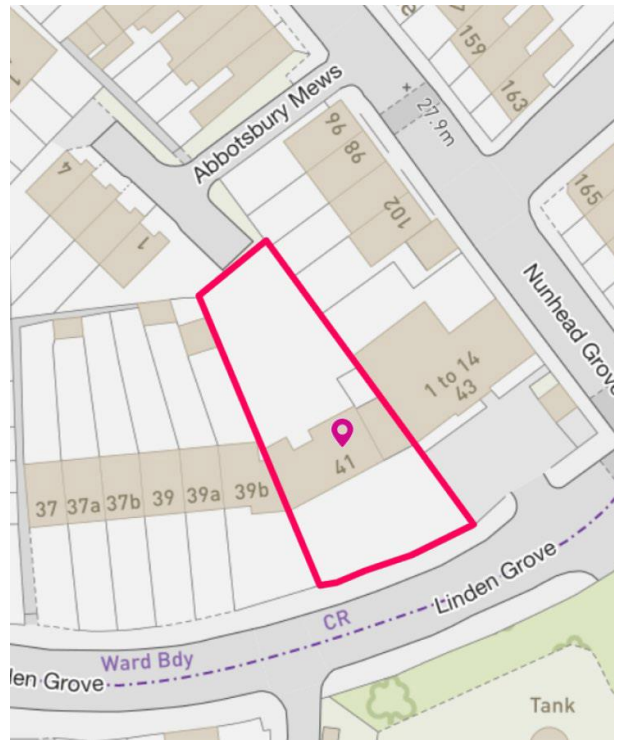
No. 41 Linden Grove, SE15

Southwark Council has made an immediate Article 4 Direction under Article 4(1) of the Town and Country Planning (General Permitted Development) (England) Order 2015 (as amended) ('GPDO').

The Direction applies to the development consisting of demolition of a building within Schedule 2, Part 11, Class B of the Order.

The demolition of the building(s) on the land as shown edged in red on the map must not be carried out unless planning permission is granted for an application made under Part 3 of the Town and Country Planning Act 1990 (as amended).

This Article 4 Direction came into operation on 27th July 2022 and will remain in force for a period of 6 months unless either confirmed as permanent before the end of that 6 months' period or withdrawn by the Council.
