

Funding Forward Plan

March 2023

This quarterly plan lists services currently funded by Southwark Council through contracts and grant funding. It is arranged by financial year, starting with the current, to show when the current funding ends. It is intended to:

- Give an overview of which department is responsible for each service
- Respond to requests from Voluntary and Community (VCS) partners for more information on funding arrangements and how these are organised.
- Help partners plan for funding opportunities, and to show the totality of services provided for residents by VCS partners.

Please note the plan does not include private sector companies.

A caveat: there is no guarantee that services currently funded will be funded again in the future. The contents of the plan are not a guarantee of future funding or future programmes. When the council needs to make reductions in its budget, the council has a commitment to give three months' notice of any changes to funding.
