(c) Penalty Charges for parking contraventions for Crownfield Road and Cann Hall Road will be increased to Band A Higher rate £120 reduced to £60 if paid within 14 days of the date of issue of the Penalty Charge Notice or lower rate £80 reduced to £40 if paid within 14 days of the date of issue of the Penalty Charge Notice;

(d) Penalty Charges for parking contraventions for all roads within the London Borough of Waltham Forest that are located south of Crownfield Road and Cann Hall Road will remain at Band B Higher rate £100 reduced to £50 if paid within 14 days of the date of issue of the Penalty Charge Notice or lower rate £60 reduced to £30 if paid within 14 days of the date of issue of the Penalty Charge Notice.

VARIATION OF BOUNDARY OF ST GEORGES CONSERVATION AREA

Notice is hereby given that the Bolton Metropolitan Borough Council (the Council) in pursuance of their powers under section 69 of the Planning (Listed Buildings and Conservation Areas) Act 1990 have designated an area within the Bolton Metropolitan Borough, described in the Schedule below to be excluded from the existing St George's Conservation Area designated boundary.

The effect of the designation, in relation to the land referred to in the Schedule below, is that special attention will not be paid by the Council to the desirability of preserving or enhancing the character or appearance of the Conservation Area. Future development and advertising in the Conservation Area will, not therefore, be subject to strict planning controls designed to secure the preservation of the character and general improvement of the area. Subject to certain exceptions the demolition of buildings and the felling and lopping of trees within the Conservation Area will not require the approval of the Council.

A copy of the plan showing the area may be inspected at the One Stop Shop, Town Hall, Bolton, on Mondays to Fridays between the hours of 9.00 am and 5.00 pm.

The variation is effective from January 18th 2010.
