

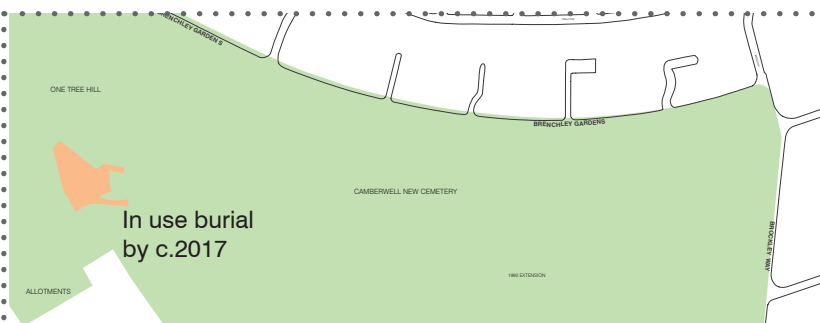
CAMBERWELL NEW CEMETERY: PROPOSALS

KEY FACTS

The Proposal:

- seeks to bring a unused area of the cemetery into use as a burial area, providing approximately 145 burial plots;
- requires minor land modelling to the existing ground levels to prepare the site for burial, and make it more easily accessible;
- involves the enlargement of an existing 'glade' area through the clearance of existing shrub vegetation, and the removal of several mature trees. Woodland surrounding the glade will be retained;

- retains existing vegetation and trees to the One Tree Hill boundary;
- includes bio diversity enhancements through additional native shrub planting and wildflower areas;
- includes a new cemetery pathway and the refurbishment of some existing pathways;
- the scheme requires the removal of some public memorials for which there are no records of ownership. All cleared memorials will be kept in storage for two months and relatives will have the opportunity to reclaim them at any time during that period
