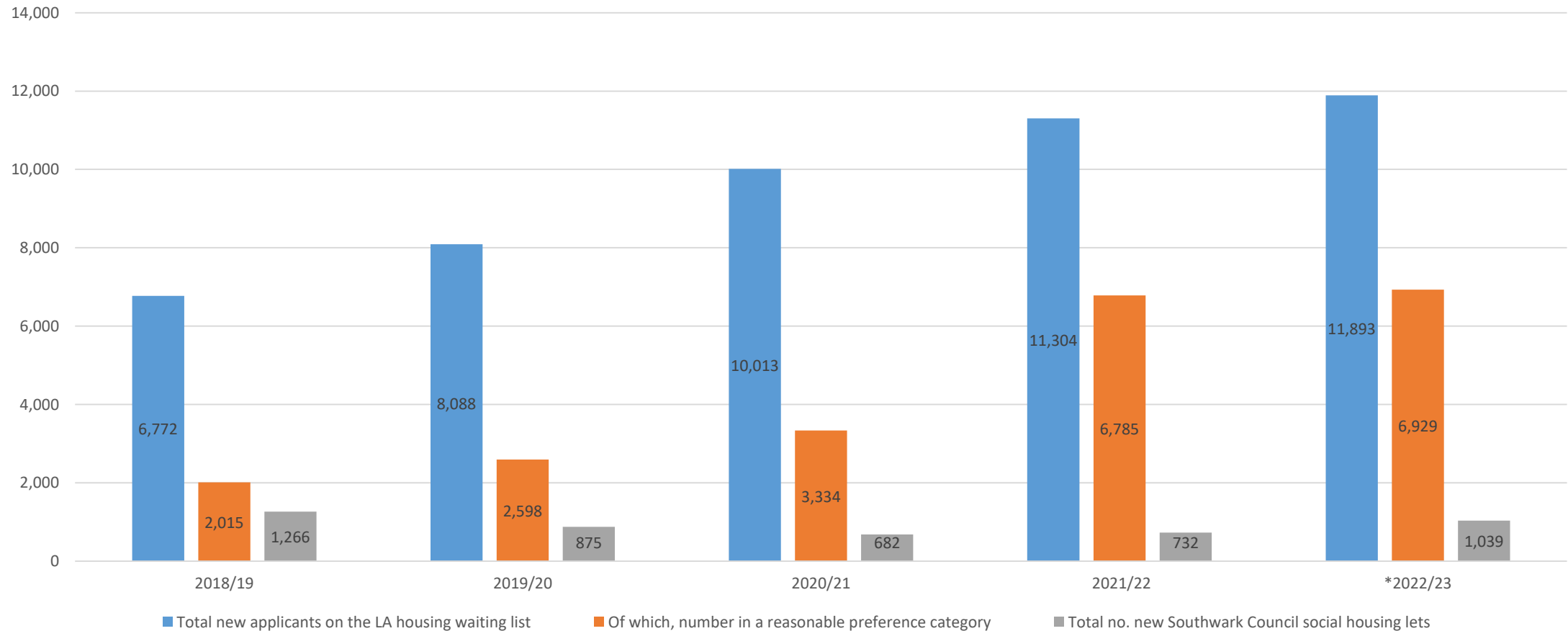
# Southwark Housing Allocations Scheme

- Why does the allocations scheme exist?
  - To meet the housing need of the borough
  - Reasonable preference
    - Homeless households and those owed homelessness duties
    - Households occupying insanitary or overcrowded housing
    - Households who need to move on medical grounds
    - Households who need to move to avoid hardship (medical treatment/to provide care)
  - Additional preference
    - Life threatening illnesses
    - Severe overcrowding
    - Homeless due to violence or threats of violence
  - Preference for members of the armed forces

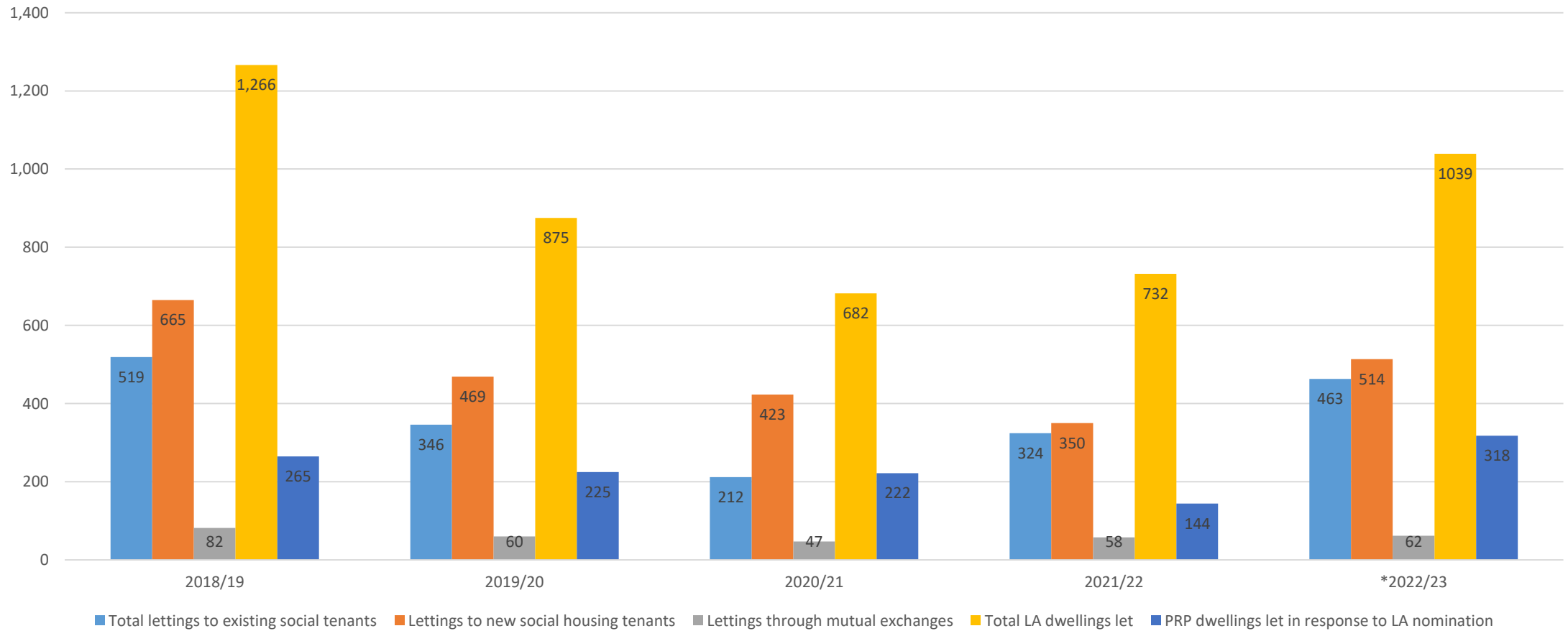

  - Prioritisation

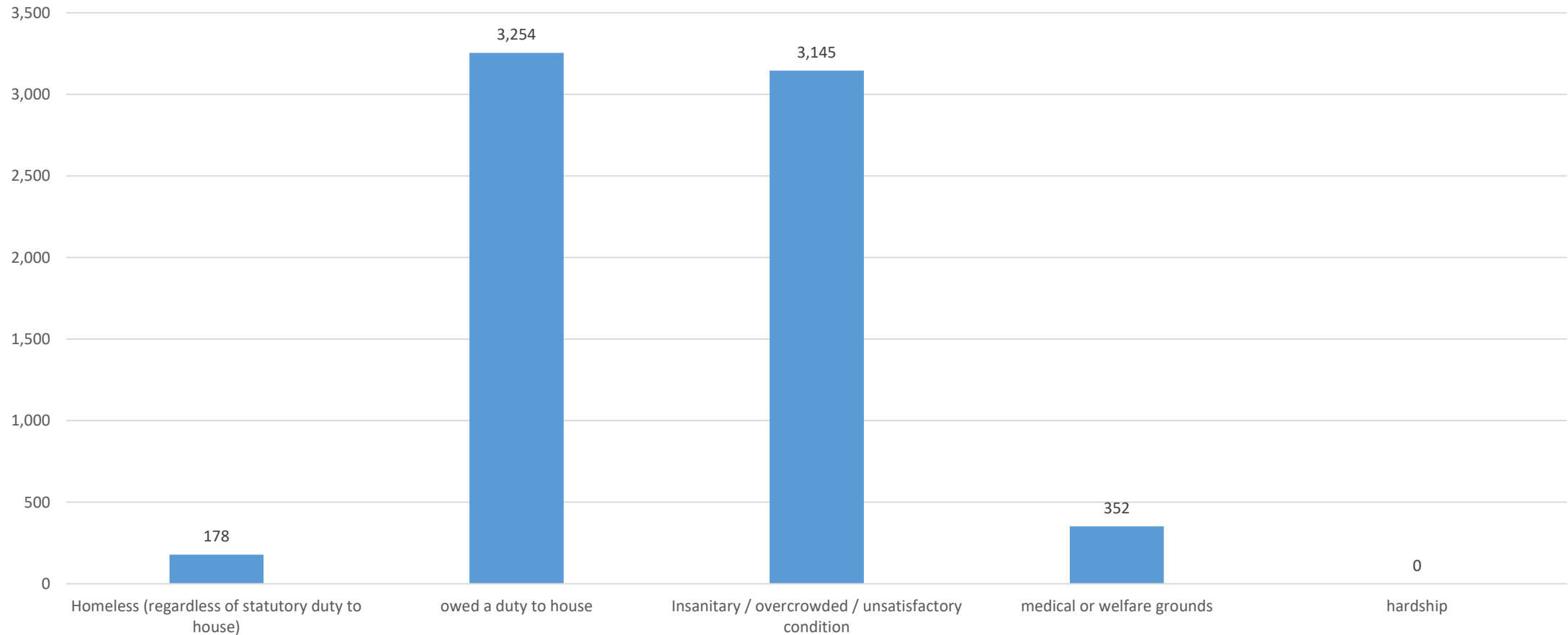
# Housing Data – Waiting list, reasonable preference, total lets



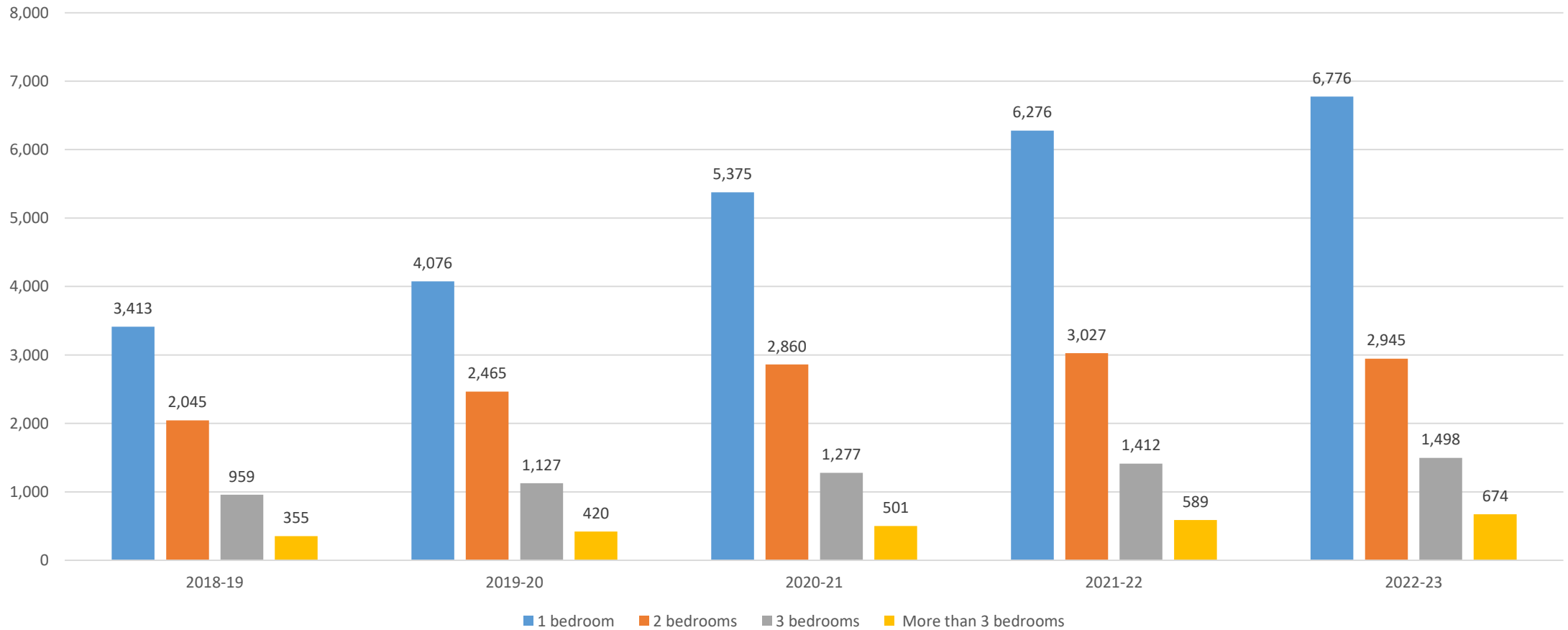
# Housing data - Lettings



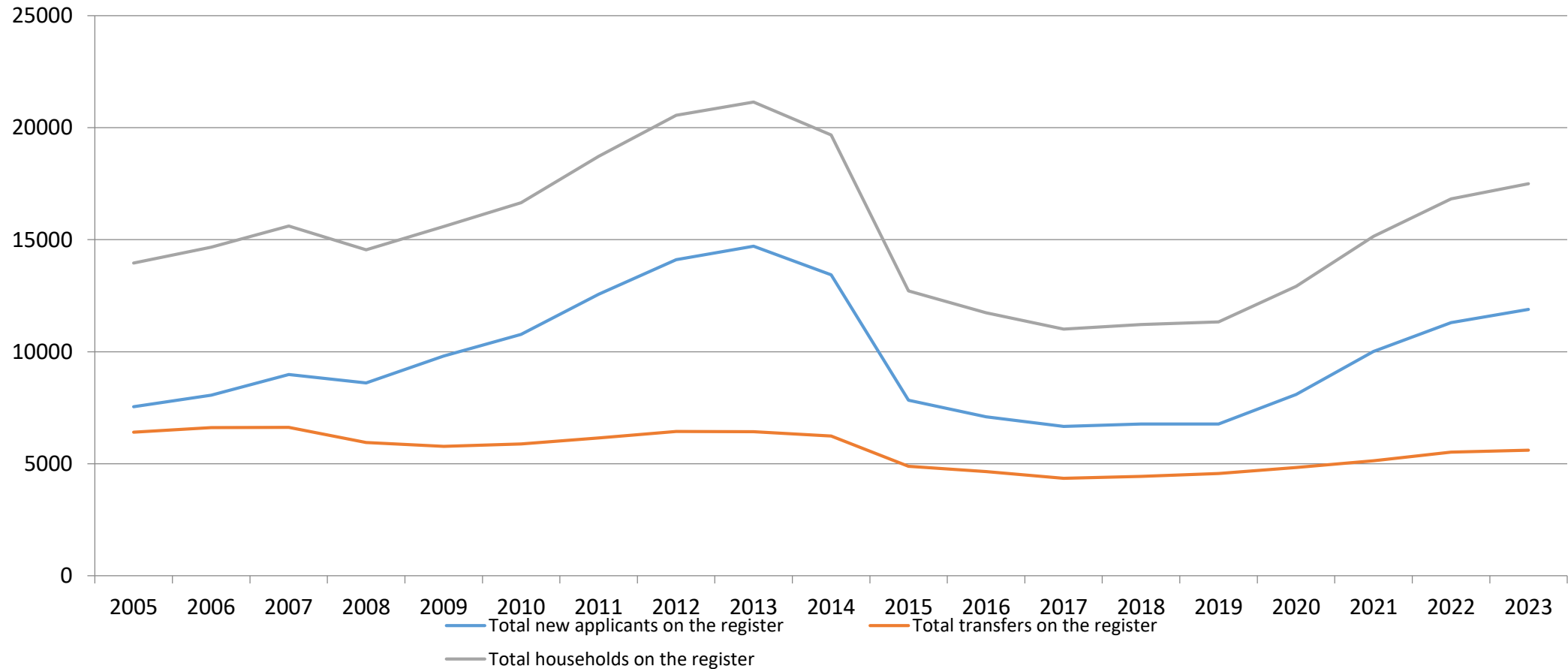
# Housing Data – Reasonable preference broken down 22/23
