Getting Involved Grants

- Funding available for local projects and activities aimed at improving the wellbeing of people who live in council homes.
- These grants of up to £5k per project are mostly aimed at Tenants & Residents Associations (TRAs) and Tenant Management Organisations (TMOs).
- If there isn't a TRA where you live you can still apply for funding if the application has been developed by and for people living in council homes. We can help you find a local organisation that can receive public funding to deliver the project .
- Traditionally these grants are open for applications once a year around March/April time but because of the current situation, this year we will be having three rounds of funding instead of one.
- There will be a shorter application period of no more than three weeks but three opportunities to apply throughout the year.



Getting Involved Grants

- The grants application period will go live in April, July and October for three weeks each time.
- There will be a virtual workshop for interested applicants where we will explain how to apply and answer questions.
- We would like one resident volunteer from each Local Housing Forum to take part in a panel to help comment and score applications. If you are interested please email resident.participation@southwark.gov.uk
