    - HOLMDENE AVENUE, on the north east side outside No. 65 Holmdene Avenue; and LYNTON ROAD, on the north-west side outside No. 265 Lynton Road.
    - These parking places would operate at any time, and may be used without time limit by vehicles displaying a valid disabled persons 'blue badge'.
  - to split an existing permit holders' parking place in HOLMDENE AVENUE so as to accommodate the provision of the new disabled persons parking place referred to above.
