Adoption Statement for the Southwark Plan 2022 on 23 February 2022

In accordance with Regulations 26 and 35 of the Town and Country Planning (Local Planning) (England) Regulations 2012 notice is hereby given that Southwark Council adopted the Southwark Plan 2022 on 23 February 2022.

The Southwark Plan 2022 was the subject of an independent examination by Philip Mileham BA(Hons) MA MRTPI and David Spencer BA(Hons) DipTP MRTPI, the Planning Inspectors appointed by the Secretary of State for Housing, Communities and Local Government. In their report following the examination, issued on 17 November 2021, the Inspectors found the Plan to be sound, subject to inclusion of a number of main modifications listed in Appendix 1 of their report. Some additional minor modifications have also been included by the Council to address factual updates and corrections.

Any person aggrieved by the Southwark Plan 2022 may make an application to the High Court under Section 113 of the Planning and Compulsory Purchase Act 2004 on the grounds that either: -

- (i) the Southwark Plan 2022 is not within the powers conferred by Part 2 of the Planning and Compulsory Purchase Act 2004, and/or
- (ii) that a procedural requirement of the Act or its associated Regulations has not been complied with.

Any such application must be made promptly and in any event no later than six (6) weeks after the date on which the Southwark Plan was adopted (i.e. no later than 6 April 2022).
