

Burgess Park fishing lake terms and conditions for use

1. All anglers must hold a valid Environment Agency Rod License when angling and carry this with them whilst angling.
2. Receipts (paper or electronic copies) confirming purchase of day ticket together with Rod Licences must be shown on request to the Environment Agency, Council Officer, or Authorised Contractor. (All carry ID).
3. All fish are the property of Southwark Council- and must be returned promptly to the swim where caught
4. A maximum of three rods may be used- with appropriate valid Rod Licences in place.
5. Angling may only take place in the designated part of the lake and on clearly defined swims
6. Junior anglers aged 12-16 years must be accompanied by an adult.
7. All anglers must use an unhooking mat and also carry with them a carp care kit at all times.
8. Tiger nut baits are the only nut bait permitted.
9. Keep nets are not allowed.
10. Day ticket times must be adhered to at all times.
11. Baited rods must not be left unattended – such equipment will be removed as lost property and stored at the Park Office for a period of 1 month, after which time it will be disposed of.
12. Landing nets should be a minimum of 36 inches in diameter and these must be dry before placing into the Lake.
13. Noise must be kept to a minimum at all times.

14. Park bylaws, Burgess Lake terms and conditions and National Fisheries bylaws must be adhered to at all times.
15. Boats or dinghies are not allowed on the lake- in line with Council Byelaws.
16. Swimming, bathing or sub aqua is not permitted.
17. No littering.
18. No BBQs, cooking stoves or naked flames allowed.
19. Verbal and physical abuse of staff and contractors will not be tolerated.
20. Any angler that does not adhere to these terms and conditions will be asked to leave the park by Southwark Council Staff, Police, or their authorised contractors.
21. Southwark Council reserves the absolute right to terminate or cancel day tickets at any time in the event of any breach of these terms and conditions and parks bylaws without notice, reimbursement or any compensation.
22. Southwark Council will not accept responsibility for any loss, damage or theft of property or personal injury whilst angling at Burgess Park Lake. Anglers fish at their own risk.
