 - Demolition:
 - i of an internal part of a building, where the building is occupied and it is intended that it should remain occupied.
 - of a building that has a cubic content (as ascertained by external measurement) of not more than 1750 cubic feet, or, where a greenhouse, conservatory, shed or prefabricated garage forms part of a larger building, of that greenhouse, conservatory, shed or prefabricated garage, or
 - iii without prejudice to sub paragraph (ii) above, of an agricultural building (as defined in section 26 of the General Rate Act 1967), unless it is contiguous to another building of a kind mentioned in that sub-paragraph

- 5. A person who fails to carry out the requirements of Section 80 of the Building Act 1980 is liable on summary conviction to a fine not exceeding level 4 on the standard scale.
- 6. All demolition work is subject to the Construction (Design & Management) Regulations 2007. It is the responsibility of the client and contractor to ensure that all requirements of these regulations are met and the Health and Safety Executive notified where appropriate.
- 7. Submission fee of £675.00 includes the cost of administration issuing the counter-notice, consultation and initial site visits. A further invoice may be issued to recover any other costs incurred.
- 8. You must send the correct charge with your building notice. If you are paying by cheque, please make it payable to 'Southwark Corporation (Building Control) '.
